ADULT PRE-CHARGE DIVERSION

PROGRAM SUMMARY

Adult Pre-Charge Diversion is a community based alternative for addressing minor incidents of crime committed by individuals age 18 and older.

To participate in the program, you must be willing to:

- Take responsibility for your actions
- Make amends for any harm that has been caused
- Meet with worker to make a formal agreement

Upon successful completion of the agreement, any pending charges will not be formally filed.

PROCESS

After receiving the referral from the police officer, a caseworker will contact you, usually within a few days, to set up a time to meet to discuss your situation. During that meeting, an agreement will be made to address any harm that has been caused. The caseworker will assist you in completing your agreement.

COST

There may be a fee for participating in this program. This can be discussed with your caseworker during the intake meeting.
