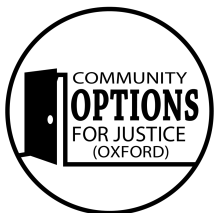


## OUR MISSION

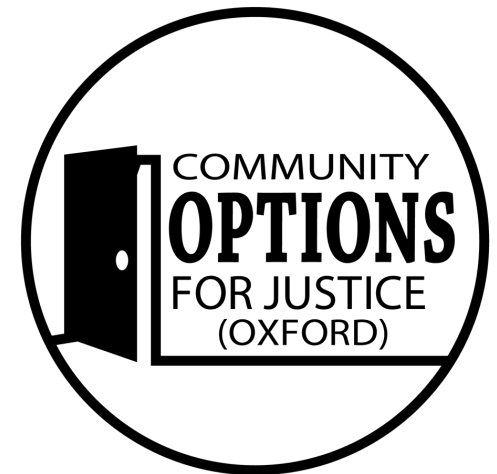

## **Youth Programs**

### **Extrajudicial Measures (EJM)**

A Pre-charge Diversion program in which a youth shows accountability by completing agreed-to sanctions, thus avoiding a charge being laid.

### **Extrajudicial Sanctions (EJS)**

A Post-charge Diversion program in which a youth shows accountability by completing agreed-to sanctions, thus having charge withdrawn.

### **Youth Justice Committee (YJC)**

Brings together people impacted by a crime in a safe manner to meaningfully address harm that has been caused.

### **Attendance Centre (AC)**

Available for youth on a Probation Order, individualized programming addresses criminogenic risk factors.

### **Integration Support**

Provides support to youth on Probation as they re-integrate into their community.

## **Adult Programs**

### **Adult Pre-Charge Diversion**

Available to police officers to hold person accountable and connect person to community supports without laying a formal charge.

### **Direct Accountability Program (DAP)**

A Post-charge Diversion program in which an adult shows accountability by completing agreed-to sanctions, thus having charge withdrawn.

### **Adult Diversion (fee-for-service)**

A Post-charge Diversion program for adults facing drug charges in which person shows accountability by completing agreed-to sanctions, thus having charge withdrawn.

### **Community Service Orders (CSO)**

A community-based sentencing option allowing the courts to order volunteers hours completed in the community.

### **Community Rehabilitative Program**

Counselling program available for adults on Probation.

## **Adult Restorative Practices**

### **Victim Offender Reconciliation Program (VORP)**

Brings together adults impacted by a crime in a safe manner to meaningfully address harm that has been caused.

### **Adult Mediation**

Available to adults experiencing conflict who are willing to meet with one another to discuss the situation with the assistance of trained mediators.

## **Community Referrals**

### **Adult Anger Management (fee-for-service)**

Introductory instruction in developing improved self-awareness and anger management techniques.

### **Skill Development for Youth**

Sessions focus on education & self-awareness, and developing skills and strategies to foster improved coping.
