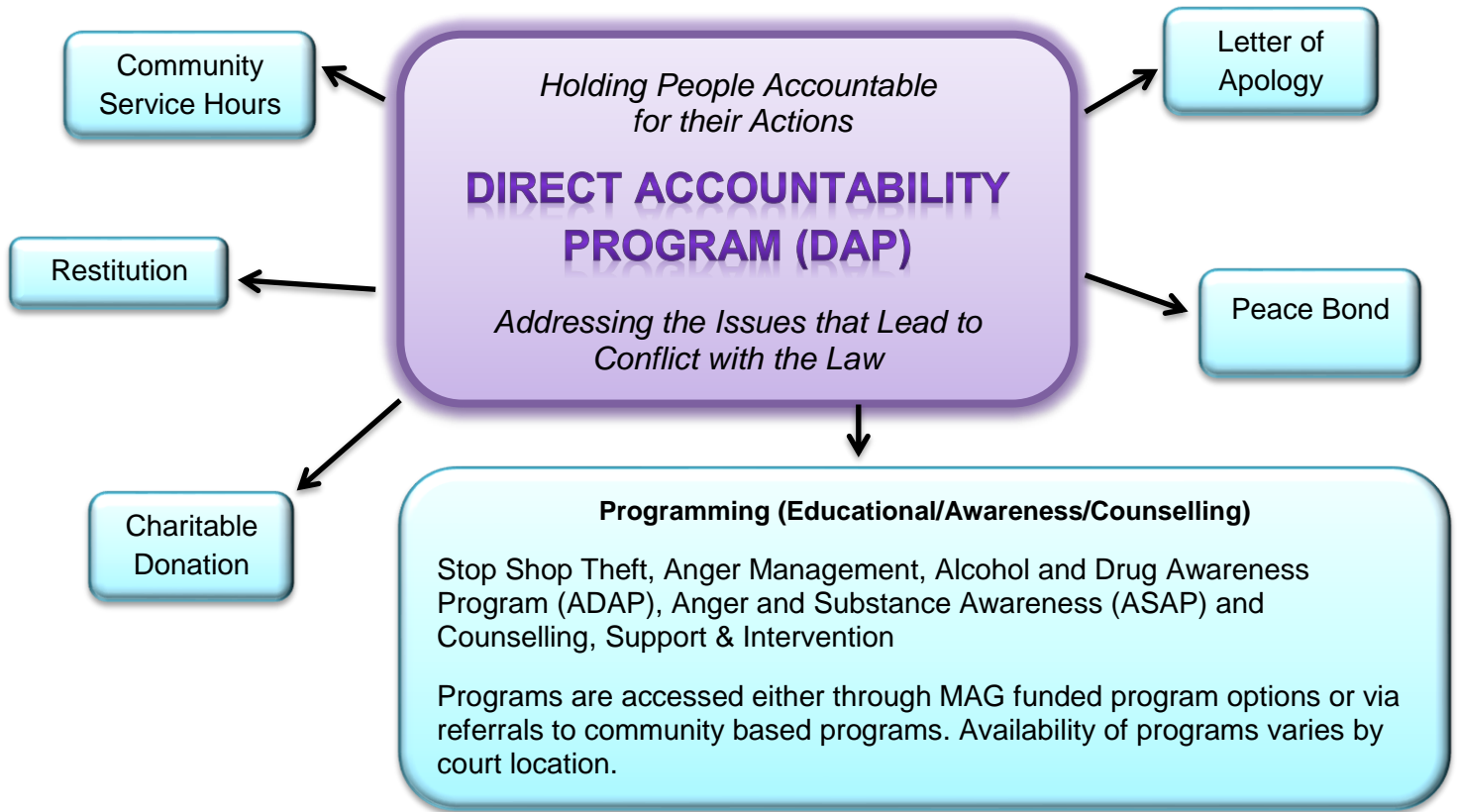


DID YOU KNOW...?

Direct Accountability cases are usually resolved within 2 court appearances and in less than 90 days from the date of referral.

In 2019, the Direct Accountability Program assigned:

- \$1,331,868 in restitution payments for victims
- 81,129 hours of community service
- \$466,637 in donations to local charities



What cases should be referred to the DAP Program?

Most Commonly Referred:

- Theft Under/Over
- Mischief Under/Over
- Fraud Under/Over
- False Pretences Under
- Take Auto Without Consent
- Possession Under/Over
- Food, Travel, Accommodation Fraud
- Causing a Disturbance
- Obstruct Peace Officer
- Uttering Threats
- Assault (non - Intimate Partner Violence)
- Break and Enter
- Utter Forged Documents
- Non-compliance Offences

Eligible

Requires Approval of Crown Attorney:

- Intimate Partner Violence Offences
- Hate Motivated Offences
- Criminal Harrassment

Presumptively Ineligible

Ineligible

- Murder, manslaughter, infanticide, criminal negligence causing death
- Driving Offences causing death or bodily harm
- Aggravated Assault
- Impaired driving, driving with a prohibited blood alcohol concentration, or refusing to provide a breath sample
- Firearms
- Criminal Organization
- Terrorism
- Kidnapping
- Voyeurism
- Publication etc. of Intimate Images without consent
- Child abuse and child luring
- Child pornography
- Home Invasions
- Robbery
- Sexual offences including sexual assault, sexual assault causing bodily harm, sexual interference and exploitation, invitation to sexual touching and incest
- Human Trafficking
- Any offence where the AG's consent was obtained to proceed

The program is **voluntary** and individuals must be willing to **accept responsibility** for the actions that led to the charge. Upon successful completion of the assigned sanction(s), the charge will be withdrawn or stayed. Records of participation will be kept for a two year period and can be brought to the Crown's attention if the individual reoffends during this period.
